Ihsan Inan, MD, FMH, FACS is a Swiss board-certified visceral and general surgeon with exclusive dedication to robot-assisted visceral surgery. Fully trained in Switzerland, he practices in Geneva where robotic surgery is used as the reference operative modality across his entire elective and emergency activity.

His main clinical and academic focus is abdominal wall surgery and reconstruction, including inguinal, ventral and incisional hernias, rectus diastasis repair, and complex parietal reconstructions using advanced minimally invasive and robotic techniques. His expertise also extends to robotic biliary surgery, colorectal surgery, and emergency visceral surgery performed with elective-level standards.

Dr Inan has developed a highly standardized robotic surgical practice integrating prehabilitation, ERAS principles, multimodal opioid-sparing analgesia, and structured postoperative follow-up, with a strong emphasis on functional outcomes and rapid recovery. He is particularly involved in technique optimization, workflow standardization, and the expansion of robotic surgery indications to complex and emergency settings.

He is an active international speaker and educator, regularly invited to present, teach, and moderate sessions on robotic surgery and abdominal wall reconstruction. His academic interests include surgical innovation, training methodologies, medico-economic aspects of robotic surgery, and the evolution of minimally invasive surgical standards.
